Report on Analysis of Students' Feedback

On Curricular Aspects

Session 2023-24

The IQAC of the institution has established a robust feedback mechanism with a primary focus on enhancing the quality of education. This involves collecting feedback from various stakeholders using a structured, rating-based form, which facilitates continuous improvements in the curriculum. The College strives to create an optimal learning environment that empowers students to reach their full potential. Through this feedback system, students have the opportunity to evaluate different aspects of the curriculum and express their level of satisfaction. The insights gathered are compiled into a report by the IQAC, which is then shared with the faculty for review and consideration during Board of Studies meetings, helping to drive curriculum enhancements.

Methodology:

Student feedback on the design and development of the curriculum was collected using a structured questionnaire, consisting of 8 questions that covered various aspects of the curriculum, along with an option for suggestions on potential improvements. A five-point Likert scale was employed to assess responses, with the following ratings assigned to different levels of agreement:

1- Strongly Disagree; 2- Disagree; 3- Neutral; 4- Agree; 5- Strongly Agree

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels,

Therefore, Range= (5-1)/5=4/5=0.8

Hence, Range for:

2	Disagree	1.8 to 2.6
3	Neutral	2.6 to 3.4
4	Agree	3.4 to 4.2
5	Strongly Agree	4.2 to 5.0



To determine that the sample is representative sample or not, sample size adequacy test was performed. **Sample Size Adequacy Test:**

To test the adequacy of sample size, Slovin's test (1960) has been used, which is as follows: $n=N/(1+Ne^2)$ Where n= Minimum Sample Size; N=Total Population; e=Error Tolerance Level In session 2023 -24, total number of students were = 6234. Taking the confidence level as 95 % & Error Tolerance= 5%; So, $n=6234/(1+6234(0.05)^2)$; n=375.88

Therefore, minimum 376 students' feedback forms were required. Since we have received 658 students' feedback forms from different faculties, so it satisfies sample size adequacy test and it is a representative sample.




Data Analysis and Interpretation:

The response of each question is tabulated as number of students' responses on five-point Likert scale, percentage of students' responses, weighted score and weighted mean score.


Relevance of Curriculum: The content is adequate and career oriented 658 responses



Value addition: The curriculum incorporates environmental, moral and social values 658 responses





Delivery of content: The course is covered effectively and efficiently 658 responses



Availability of resources: The resources for learning are adequate and easily available 658 responses



Availability of program: There is ample choice of subject combination or availability of electives. 658 responses



Overall academic atmosphere: The overall academic atmosphere in the college is excellent 658 responses



The feedback on curricular aspects reveals that the average Weighted Mean Score all questions is which lies between Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 (the range for Agree) and concluded that, on an average, students agree that the curricular contents and available courses are included with value addition, practical, Project work and field work. The course contents are effectively delivered through live lectures/ Notes/ Video lectures and learning are adequate and easily available in the departments. There is ample choice of subject combination or availability of electives ensuing very good academic atmosphere in the institution.
