Focusing on quality enhancement, the IQAC of the institution has implemented a structured feedback mechanism, beginning with the collection of feedback from various stakeholders through a rating-based form, aimed at driving continuous curriculum improvement. The College is dedicated to providing an optimal learning environment that empowers students to achieve their full potential. Feedback from alumni plays a crucial role in evaluating and identifying gaps in the curriculum, with their responses reflecting levels of satisfaction. These insightful suggestions are compiled into a report by the IQAC, which is then shared with faculty members for review and consideration in Board of Studies meetings, facilitating further curriculum refinement.

Methodology:

The feedback from alumni on design and development of curriculum was obtained through
Structured Questionnaire which included 09 questions on various aspects of curriculum and suggestion for further improvement.

A five-point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follows:

1- Strongly Disagree; 2- Disagree; 3- Neutral; 4- Agree; 5- Strongly Agree

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels

Therefore, Range= (5-1)/5=4/5=0.8




Data Analysis and Interpretation:

Relevance of Curriculum: The Curriculum was relevant and career oriented. 301 responses







Value Addition: The curriculum visualizes moral, social, ethical and environmental values. 301 responses













The Alumni feedback on curricular aspects reveals that the average Weighted Mean Score all questions is 3.93 which lies between Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 (the range for Agree) and concluded that, on an average, Alumni strongly agree that the curricular contents and available courses are included with applied aspects, value addition and skill development courses. The course contents are effectively delivered through live lectures/ Notes/ Video lectures and learning are adequate and easily available in the departments. There is ample choice of subject combination or availability of electives ensuing very good academic atmosphere in the institution.

Suggestions:

- 1. Smart or e-classes should be a necessary part of teaching.
- 2. Industrial visit and internships should be compulsory in all programs.
- 3. More moral, social, ethical and environmental values need to be included
- 4. Life skills and Linguistic knowledge must be part of every disciplines.
- 5. Entrepreneurship and basics of business management must be incorporated for most disciplines.
- 6. Career guidance and Research must be equipped with advance resources.
- 7. Coaching for CSIR NET and GATE examination should be provided.
