**Scale: 1. Strongly Agree 2. Agree 3. Neither Agree nor Disagree 4. Disagree 5. Strongly Disagree**

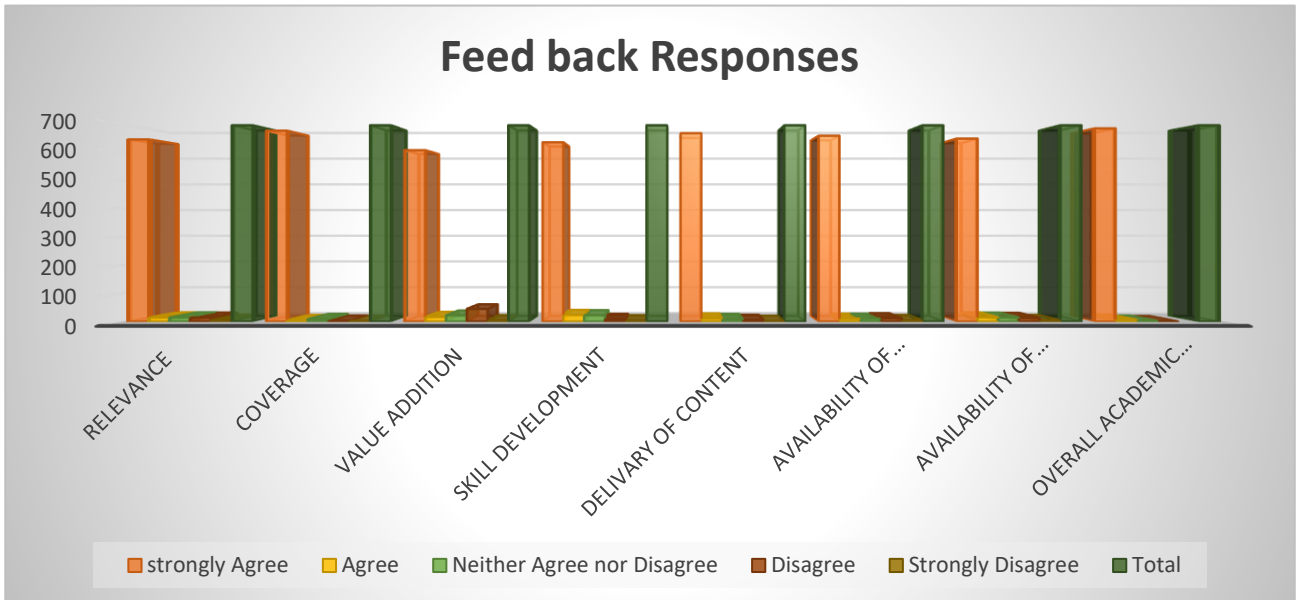

**IQAC Analysis of Student's Feedback on Curriculum:**

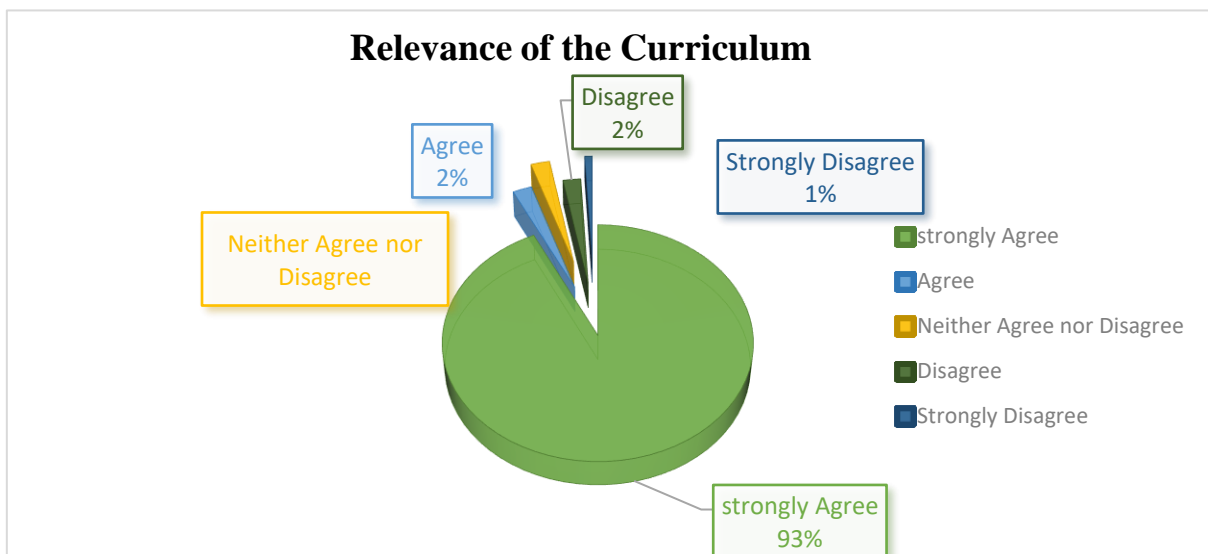

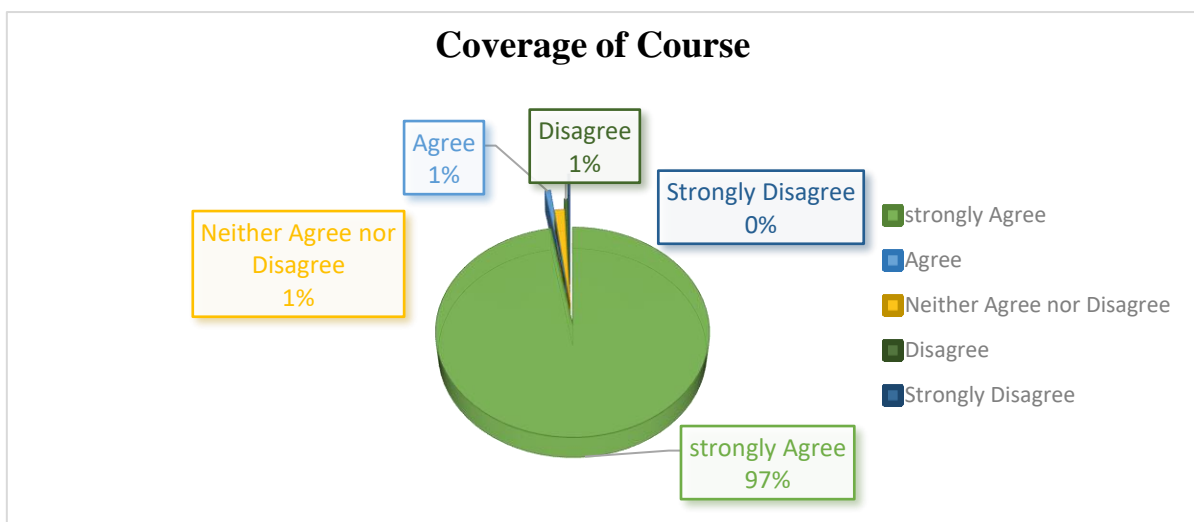


**Q.1 Relevance of Curriculum: The content is adequate and career oriented**



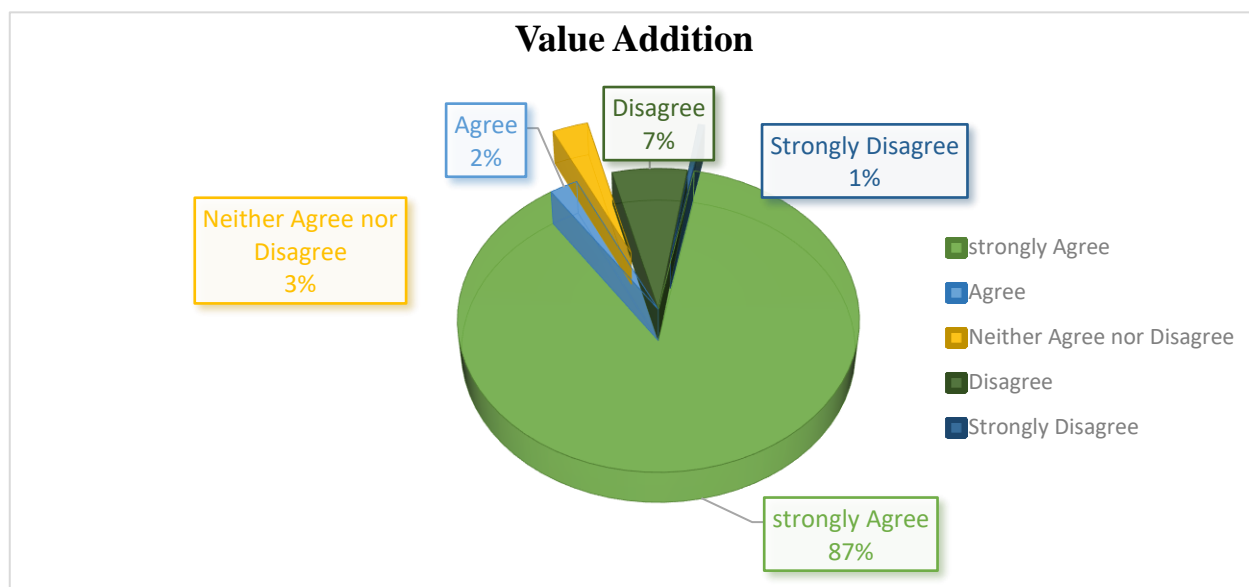
About Relevance of the Curriculum, 93% of the students strongly agreed but rest 7% are of the opinion that some changes are needed to make it more relevant.

**Q. 2 Coverage of Course: The course includes fundamental and applied aspect**



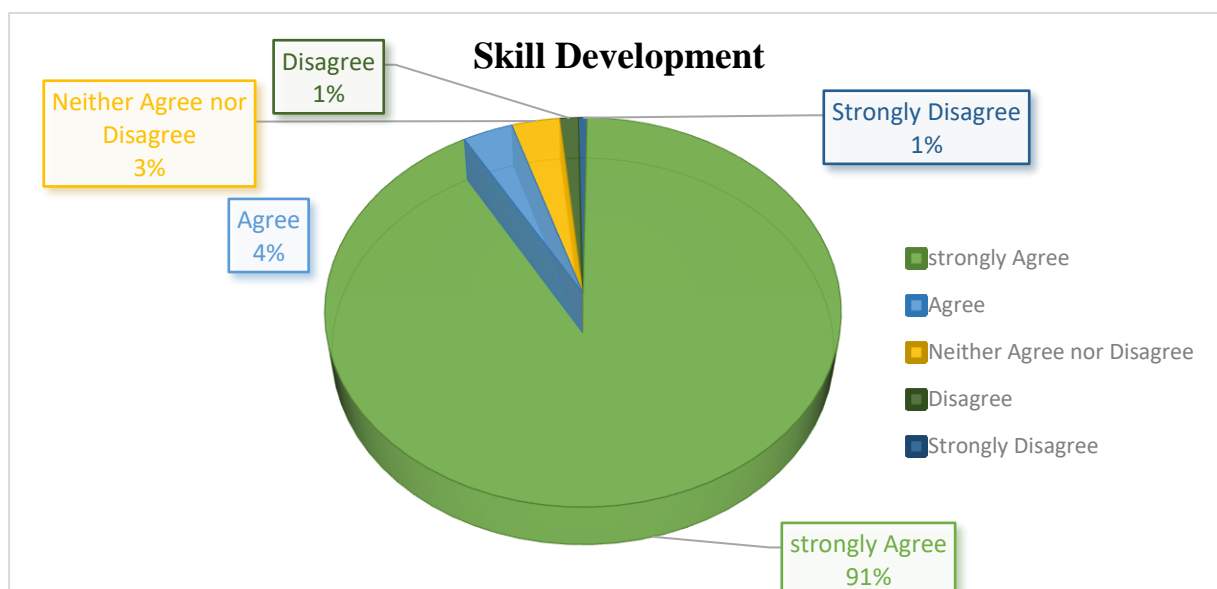
Regarding coverage of the course 97% students were of the opinion that course is completed in the class where as 3% believe that whole course is not completed in some classes.

**Q. 3 Value addition: The curriculum incorporates environmental, moral and social values.**



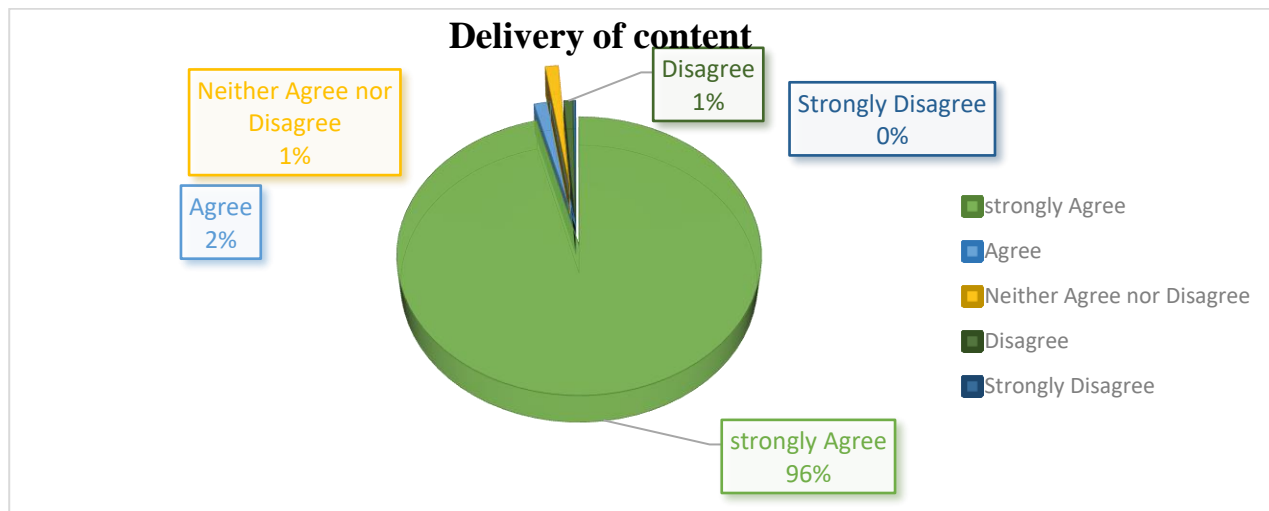
About Value Addition, 87% students strongly agreed but 13% students seek changes and introduction of such courses and changes in the curriculum to make it more employability.

**Q. 4 Skill development: The curriculum is supported with practical/Field work/Project work/other activities**



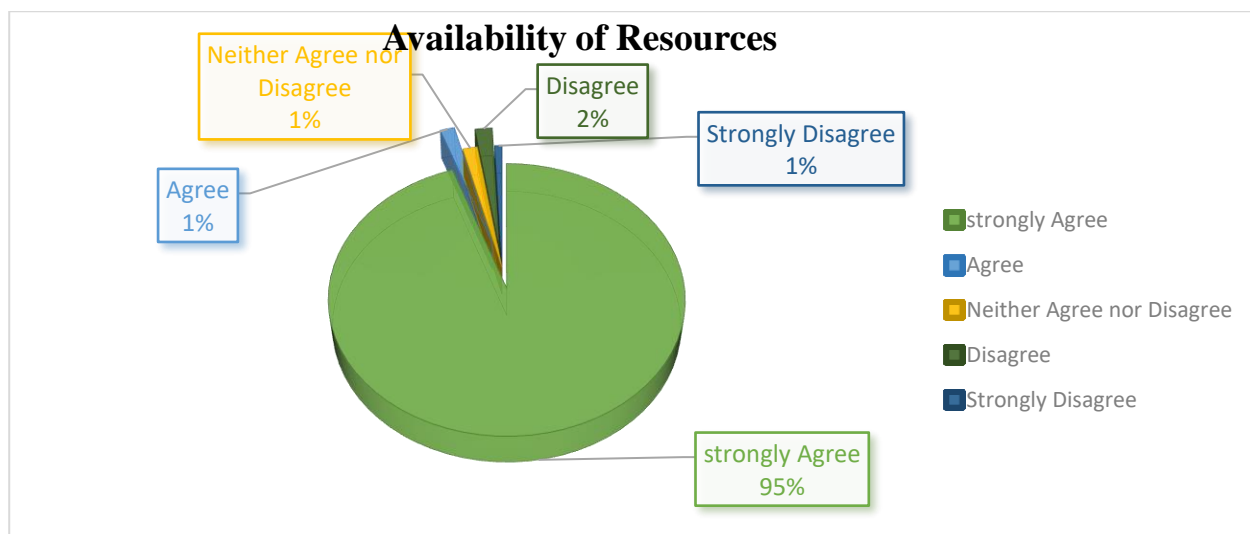
Only 91% students agreed that the curriculum is skill based but 9% students seek modification in the present curriculum. They suggested that more certificate and diploma courses must be introduced.

**Q. 5 Delivery of content: The course is covered effectively and efficiently**



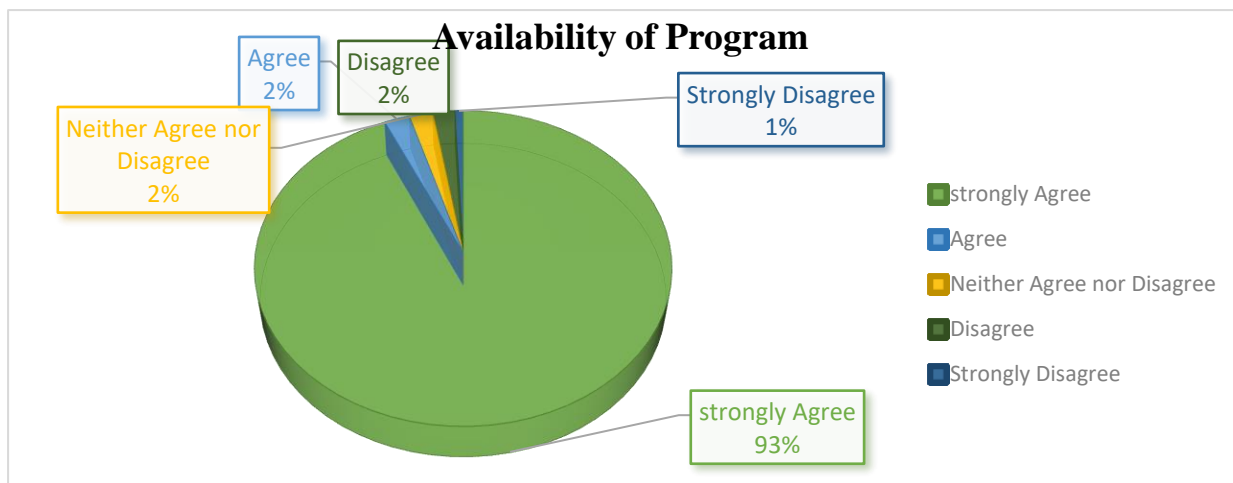
Regarding delivery of content, 96% students strongly agreed about it while 4% showed different opinion.

**Q. 6 Availability of resources: The resources for learning are adequate and easily available**



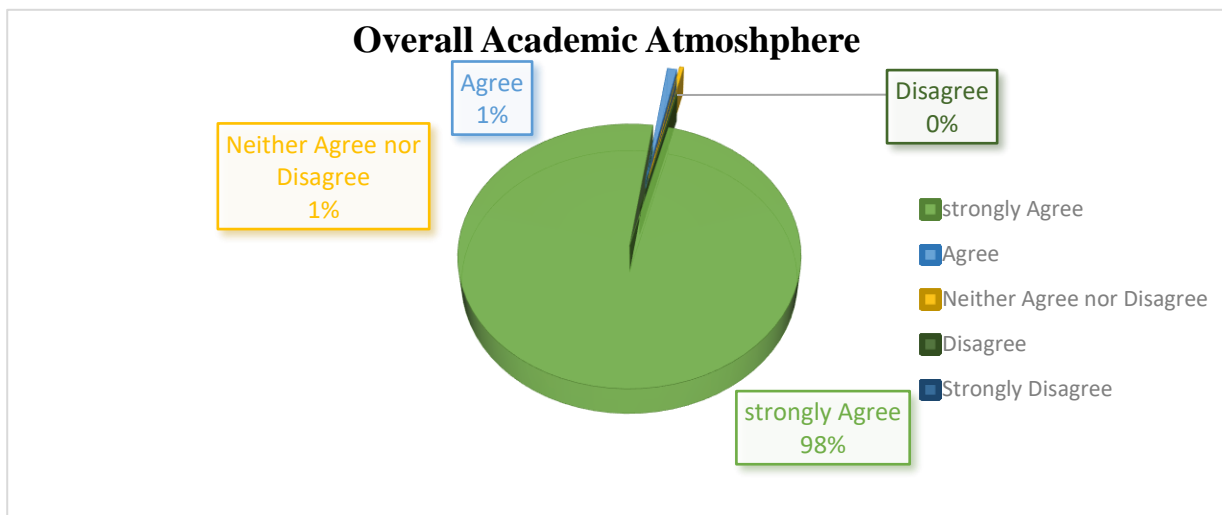
The feedback of the students reveals that 95% believe that they are satisfied with the resources available in the college while four percent differ from rest and believe that resources are needed to be increased.

**Q. 7 Availability of programme: There is ample choice of subject combination or availability of electives**



93% of the students are satisfied with the availability of the different programs in different streams but 7% believes that more courses should be introduced specially those courses which are in demand now.


### Q. 8 Overall academic atmosphere: The overall academic atmosphere is excellent




About academic atmosphere, 98% of students are happy and satisfied with the curriculum, classes, teachers and all the available facilities while 2% do not agree.
