






Q.1 Relevance of Curriculum: The content is adequate and career oriented



Q. 2 Coverage of Course: The course includes fundamental and applied aspect




Regarding coverage of the course 89% students were of the opinion that course is completed in the class where as 11% believe that whole course is not completed in some classes.




Q. 3 Value addition: The curriculum incorporates environmental, moral and social values.


About Value Addition, 81% students strongly agreed but 12% students agreed and rest seeks changes and introduction of such courses and changes in the curriculum to make it more employability

Q. 4 Skill development: The curriculum is supported with practical/Field work/Project work/other activities









Regarding delivery of content, 78% students strongly agreed about it while 15% agreed but 7% disagreed.

Q. 6 Availability of resources: The resources for learning are adequate and easily available





The feedback of the students reveals that 92% believe that they are satisfied with the resources available in the college while eight percent differ from rest and believe that resources are lacking and not available to all.





79% of the students are satisfied and strongly agreed with the availability of the different programs in different streams but 16% agreed believes that more courses should be introduced and specially those courses which are in demand now while 5% disagreed.





About academic atmosphere, 95% of students are happy and satisfied with the curriculum, classes, teachers and all the available facilities while 5% believe do not strongly agree.
